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Introduction

This report results from the analysis of the evaluation questionnaires of the training process administered to all trainees anonymously. The questionnaire contained closed questions, which were treated through descriptive statistical analysis, and open questions to which content analysis was performed.

Characterization of the Trainee Group

The first group of trainees was made up of 13 Judges from the Civil, Commercial, Family and Children, Enforcement and Labour areas, working in the Judicial Court of the District of Vila Real, who enrolled in the training action either through the online form made available for this purpose, or through the President Judge of the District.

The second group of trainees was made up of 10 Bailiffs from the Civil, Commercial, Family and Children, Enforcement and Labour areas, working at the Judicial Court of Vila Real, who enrolled in the training action either through the online form made available for this purpose, or through the Judicial Administrator of the District.

Global Results

Overall Assessment - Judges

The questions: "*Overall have a positive opinion of the training*" and "*Would you recommend this training to a co-worker*" were answered by 69% of the trainees with "*Strongly Agree*".

Overall Assessment – Bailiffs

The questions: "*Overall have a positive opinion of the training*" and "*Would you recommend this training to a co-worker*" were answered by 83% of the trainees with "*Strongly Agree*".

Results by Question

Syllabus - Judges

The questions related to the syllabus present, on average, a satisfaction rate of 85%.

Program Content – Bailiffs

The questions related to the syllabus present, on average, a satisfaction rate of 100%.

Trainers – Judges

These questions have a high satisfaction rate, with an average rate of 69%.

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Trainers – Bailiffs

These questions have the highest satisfaction rate of all the answers under analysis, with an average satisfaction rate of 93%.

Organisation of training – Judges

Questions related to support documentation, administrative support and compliance with the training schedule have an average rate of 73%.

Organization of Training – Bailiffs

Questions related to supporting documentation, administrative support and compliance with the training schedule have an average rate of 95%.

Results and expectations – Judges


The questions "*The expectations prior to the training have been fulfilled*" and "*Will this training be useful in your work*" obtained 85% of answers "*I totally agree*".

Results and expectations – Bailiffs

The questions "*The expectations prior to the training have been fulfilled*" and "*Will this training be useful in your work*" obtained 100% of answers "*I totally agree*".

Most useful subjects for professional activity – Judges

Among the four options available, admitting multiple answers, Regulation (EU) 2020/1784, on Service and Regulation (EU) 2020/1783, on the Taking of Evidence, were considered by the trainees as the most useful subjects for their professional activity.




